Highlights

- No new confirmed cases since 11APR2020
- H2S2 sampling teams are onsite at a building in Phnom Penh to test 116 residents and staff
- No new cases were confirmed among residents and staff tested at the first two H2S2 sites
- The Surveillance Team is working with RGC security services to improve information collection during interviews of confirmed cases by security personnel, particularly cases exported to other countries

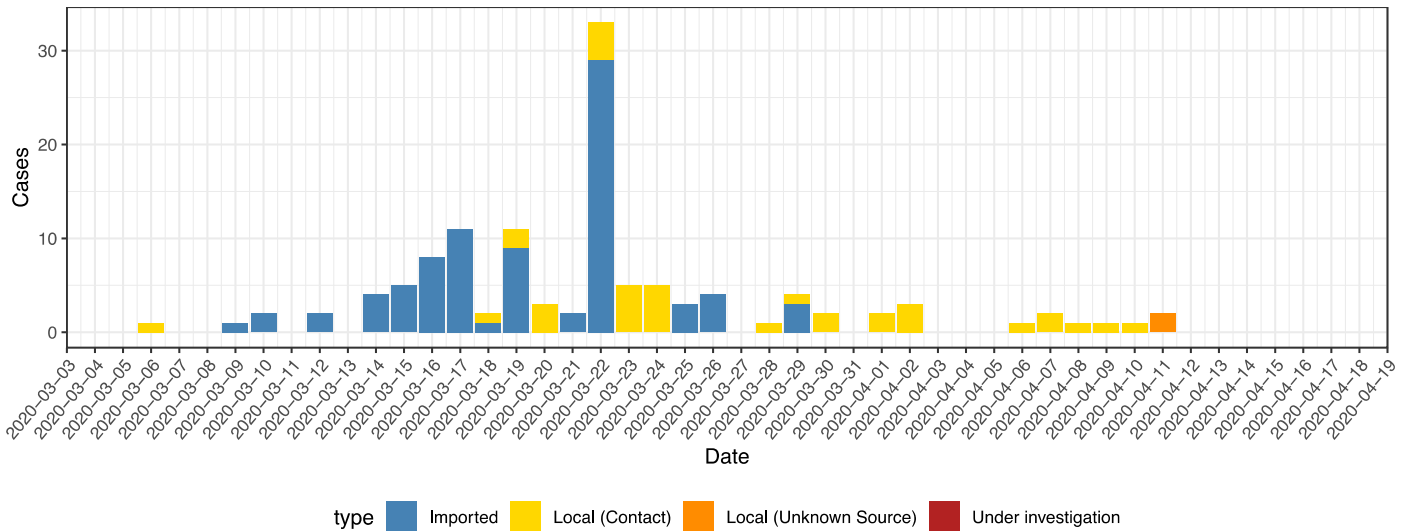

Confirmed Cases*

To date (19/04/2020), there have been 122 confirmed cases and 1 probable cases of COVID-19; 85 linked to overseas travel, 36 locally acquired linked to cases confirmed in Cambodia or abroad, and 2 locally acquired of unknown source.

Figure 1: Confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19 by acquisition status and date of positive test, beginning 03 March 2020 (extracted 19/04/2020)

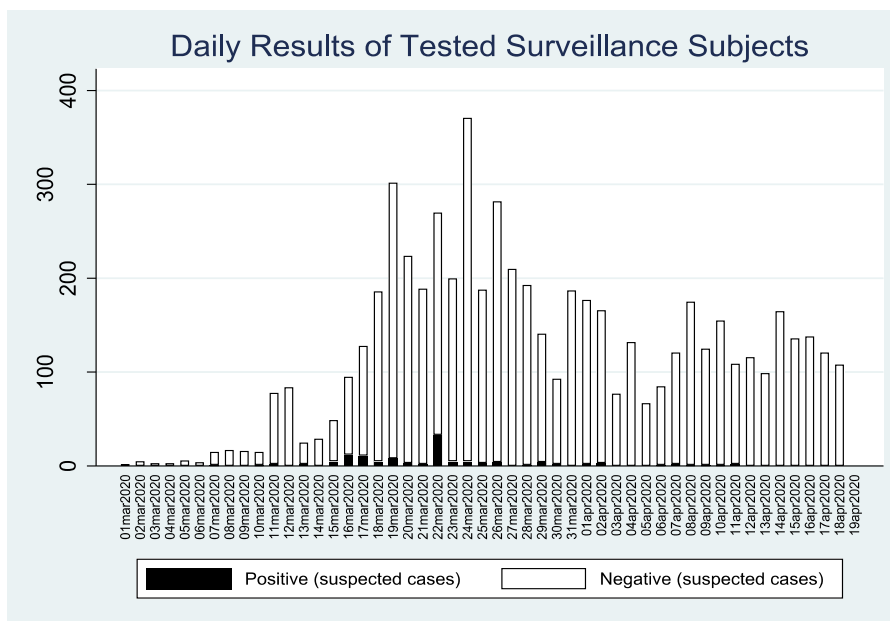
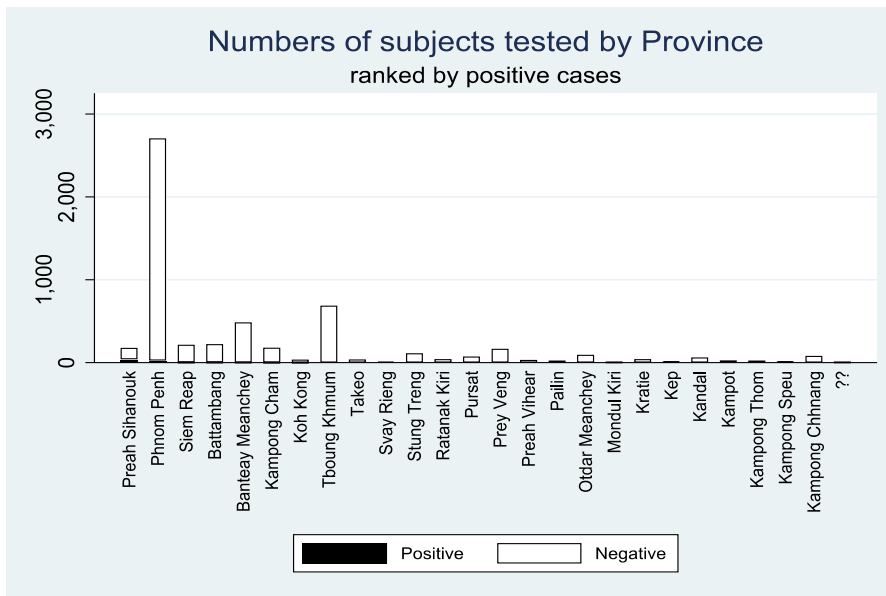

Counts of COVID-19 confirmed case contacts currently under follow-up, by case location at diagnosis

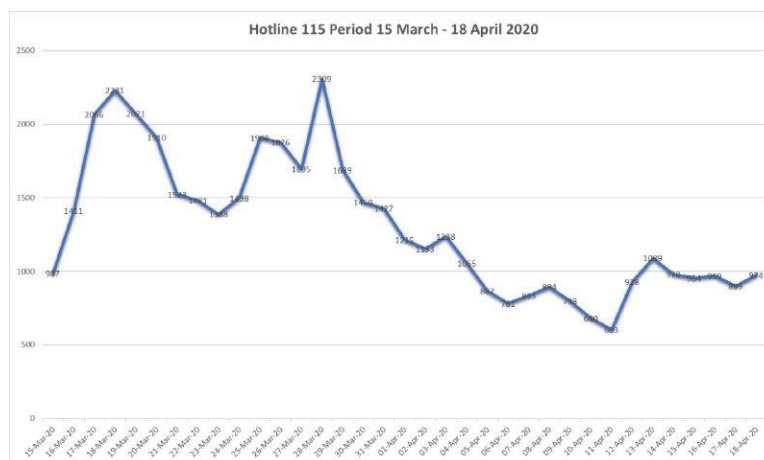

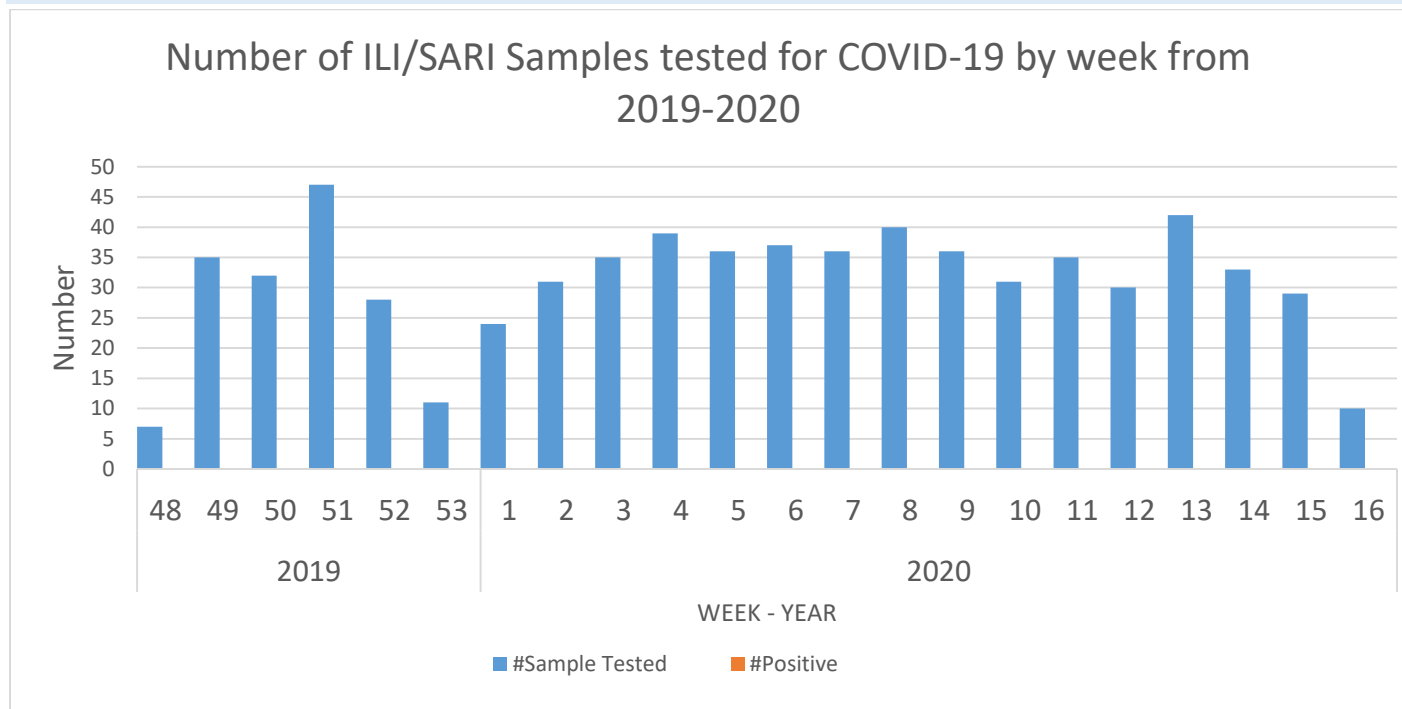
Calls to 115 Hotline
